Jason Cranford – Cranford is the founder of the Flowering H.O.P.E. Foundation, a health care associate for the Society for Cannabis Clinicians, and an expert botanist specializing in the organic cultivation of medical grade marijuana and the development of highly medicinal marijuana infused products. Cranford has more than 25 years of experience in greenhouse and indoor cultivation with successful projects in multiple climates and elevations. He is also an expert in extractions and infusions, using a variety of solvents and delivery systems. Working as a licensed general contractor for 20+ years has also given him a comprehensive knowledge of the intricacies of Grow Room building and design. For the past four years, he has successfully bred and produced a 95% CBD plant that has been verified through two independent labs. He is also the developer of several CBD rich infused products including Cannatol™ 1:1 & Haleigh's Hope.

Janea Cox - Janea Cox is the mother of Haleigh Cox, the namesake for Jason Cranford's Haleigh's Hope CBD oil medication. Haleigh has Lennox Gastaut Syndrome, an intractable seizure disorder. Cox became actively involved



in the fight for medical cannabis in 2013 after Haleigh was admitted to the pediatric intensive care unit at an Atlanta area hospital for two months. After conventional seizure medications were ineffective in treating Haleigh's condition, Cox relocated to Colorado in search of healthier alternatives for Haleigh's treatment to save her life. It was that journey that led her to Jason Cranford and the creation of Haleigh's Hope. Cox has more than 10 years in the medical field as a Firefighter/EMT and is well educated in the field of cannabis therapy for children and adults.

Sebastien Cotte – Sebastian Cotte became actively involved in the field of medical marijuana in 2013 while seeking alternative treatments for his son Jagger who was suffering from a rare terminal genetic disease. Like many other families, Cottee and his wife Annette became medical refugees in Colorado to access cannabis oil for Jagger as their home state didn't have a medical cannabis law. Cotte received a bachelor's degree in international business from the University of Indianapolis and will bring his 15 years of business experience at several Fortune 500 companies to the Flowering H.O.P.E. Foundation. His areas of expertise include human resources, training, process improvements, sales management, customer care, marketing, and brand building. He is also completing a medical marijuana certification program offered by Americans for Safe Access and the Cannabis Training Institute. He is not only an active member in the medical marijuana community, but also serves as an ambassador for the United Mitochondrial Disease Foundation, an organization that provides education, awareness and resources to health care professionals, patients and families affected by Mitochondrial disease.

"I love meeting, working with, and seeing all of our brave patients and their families. Watching all of the changes that cannabis makes possible for them is so amazing," she says.

Heather Cranford - Heather Cranford has been involved with the Flowering H.O.P.E. Foundation from the beginning after volunteering her time in operations and management. She has watched the Foundation's grassroots operation stay grounded and humble, while growing at exponential speeds.
